

## PHIL100 Format for final exam

### I. Terms (Choose 15 from a list of 17, worth 7 pts each)

The terms come from the first handout given by Prof Odell (“Definitions and Logic Exercises”). From that list, you should know:

as far as the terms go, the list of things to know:

- 1) All terms on page 1
- 2) nothing on page 2 (except for the first: “sufficiency condition”)
- 3) everything on the bottom half of page 3 (beginning with “animism”)
- 4) everything on page 4 *except* the last term (“individualistic interpretation of subjective act utilitarianisms”)
- 5) everything on page 5 up to and including FBPC (nothing then after that)

**II.) Ethics essay. (50pts total) Explain and critically discuss one question you choose from a list of three questions (material on ethics, i.e., everything covered after exam II)**
