

CPSG101: CARBON FOOTPRINT INFOGRAPHIC

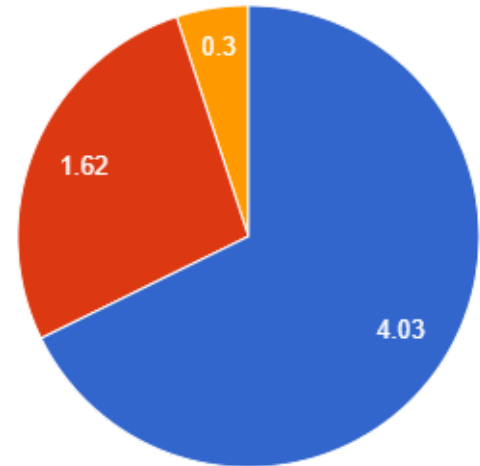

PRESENT CARBON FOOTPRINT (t CO₂/yr)

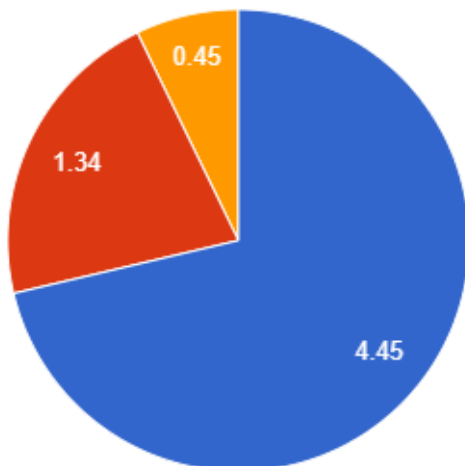
● Household and Food ● Transportation ● Air Travel
