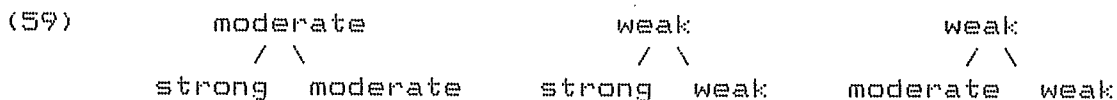
- (1) There^d is a man^d here
- (2) There is usually a man here
- (3) *I heard usually a car (cf. I usually heard a car)
- (4) There is likely [t to be someone here]
- (5) *There is likely [someone to be here]
- (6) *We consider [there a man in the room]
- (7) We consider [there to be a man in the room]
- (8) I consider [there *(to be) a solution]
- (9) We consider [there_i likely [t_i to be a man in the room]]
- (10) Case is assigned only under government by a Case assigner.
- (11) A car is not here
- (12) *I heard not a car
- (13) John [_{AUX} Tense [v will]] [_{VP} leave]
- (14) John [_{AUX} Tense [v do]] [_{VP} leave]
- (15) [[A car] [Tense be_i] [not t_i here]
- (16) Is a car here
- (17) *Heard I a car
- (18) There is usually a man here.
- (19) There [Tense be_i] [usually t_i a man here]
- (20) Will a car be here
- (21) *Will be a car here
- (22) A car will not be here

- (23) *A car will be not here
- (24) [[A car] [Tense will] [not be here]]
- (25) ?*There will be usually a man here
- (26) *I heard usually a car
- (27)a John is not noisy
 b John [Tense be₁] [not t₁ noisy]
- (28)a *Be not noisy
 b [IMP e] [not be noisy] (-> Do not be noisy)
- (29) ?*I believe John to be not here
 cf. I believe John is not here
- (30) ?*I believe John to be not singing
 cf. I believe John is not singing
- (31) I believe John not to be here
- (32) I believe John not to be singing
- (33) *I believe there to be not a solution
- (34) *I believe there to be usually a solution
- (35) I believe there not to be a solution
- (36) ?I believe there usually to be a solution
- (37) I believe there is not a solution
[Tense be₁] [not t₁ a solution]
- (38) I believe there is usually a solution
[Tense be₁] [usually t₁ a solution]
- (39) ?There arrived a bus
- (40) ?There usually arrives a bus (at this time)
- (41) *There arrives usually a bus (at this time)
- (42) There is usually a man here
- (43) *There arrived not a bus [?There did not arrive a bus]
- (44) *A bus arrived not [A bus did not arrive]
- (45) *Arrived a bus [Did a bus arrive]

- (46) *John likes not Mary
 (47) Jean (n')aime pas Marie
 (48) [Aff [V [Aff]]]
 (49) John is not noisy
 (50) *Be not noisy
 (51) Do not be noisy
 (52) *I believe there to be not a solution
 (53) I believe there is not a solution
 (54) ?*I believe John to be not here
 (55) I believe John is not here
 (56) ?*I believe John to be not singing
 (57) I believe John is not singing
