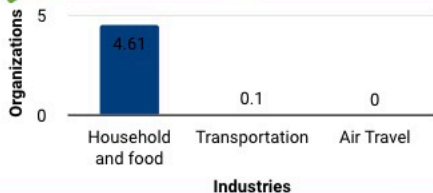

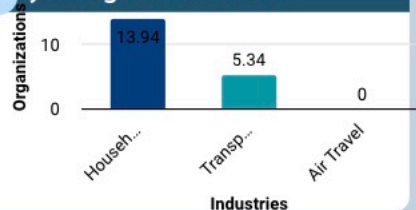


University Carbon FootPrint
